

2021 - 2022 Covid Policy for Staff & Students

Effective 8/30/21

- All staff and students, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth.
- Any staff or student who is vaccinated should submit the card to be kept in their school records.
- Any staff or student testing **positive** will remain in isolation for 10 days and will return after that time when symptom free.
- A positive test in the household will require a quarantine; non vaccinated can test out after 7 days and return after day 10; fully vaccinated can return with a mask as long as they are non-symptomatic.
- Any positive test should be reported to the school at 203-924-6651.
- Unvaccinated close contact with a positive person will require a 14 day quarantine period.
- If a staff member or student has a fever, loss of taste, loss of smell, vomiting and or diarrhea regardless of vaccination status they should stay home from school. If a staff member or student has multiple symptoms which include cough, congestion, headache, and sore throat should stay home until symptoms clear.
- Any absence of **three** or more consecutive days will require a negative PCR test or medical clearance to return to school.
- Domestic travel: any travel for three consecutive days must test with a PCR test within 48 hours prior to their return to school.
- International travel: unvaccinated students will test 3 5 days after travel and self-quarantine for 7 days, even with a negative test result. Vaccinated students will require a test 3 5 days after travel.

Only PCR tests will be accepted and results are required in writing.
