

Grammar Websites

Vrae.org is the website that comes up automatically on the school computers

Click resources – click GED websites for students

Scan down the right side to roadtogrammar.com

Select from these following categories: 2. Adjectives or nouns

4. Adverbs

5. Adverbs 2

35. Cause and Effect

46. Comparative Adjectives

48. Comparative adverbs

171. Noun or Verb

175. North, South, East, and West

313. Subject/Verb Agreement

Once a category is selected, you may choose quiz in order to take a ten or twenty-five question quiz on the topic. You may decide to first pick notes, which will give you a background on the topic before you try the quiz.

OR

Go back to the vrae.org resources page and click GED websites for students

Scan down and click on English Zone

Click on Easy level adjectives – click on Find the adjective 02 or....

Click on Find the adverb 01 (in the second column)

OR

Go back to the vrae.org resources page and click GED websites for students

Scan down to englishgrammar.com, click and scan the left side of the page and select either :

Click adjectives and adverbs

Click pronouns

Click Personal Pronouns –Ex. 1 or Ex. 2

GRAMMAR WEBSITES II

Type in vrae.org on the website line – it comes up automatically when you click google chrome on the school computers.

Go to resources (top right)

Click GED websites for students

Scan down on the right side to roadtogrammar.com and click it

There are 365 grammar topics to choose from. You can look at notes on the topics or take a quizzes on the topics

Any time you want to get back to the topics list you can click menu on the top right hand corner or if you finish a quiz or lesson it will show you to click back to menu

OR

vrae.org on the website line – go to resources (top right) – Click GED websites for students

Scan down to english-zone.com - Click it

Go to grammar zone and click confusing words – you can choose from confusing words lessons 01 – 04 or from confusing words quizzes 01 – 04

Or

Go to spelling zone and click on capitalization – you can ^{do} capital letters lessons or quizzes on first words, titles, or names.

OR

vrae.org on the website line – go to resources (top right) – Click on GED websites for students

Scan down to englishgrammar.com – Click it

Click Pronouns – You can pick from any of the first six pronoun exercises

Go to vrae.org which the school computers automatically open to

Go to resources and click GED websites for students

Scroll down to Minneapolis List of Websites for Adult Education (on the right)

Click 10 GED2 - then click 24 Social Studies

Click GED 2014 Practice Questions – there are two sets of social studies practice questions

OR

Go back to the page With the Minneapolis Websites for Adult Education (start again at vrae.org if you can't)

Click Minneapolis Websites for Adult E – Click 11 GED – Click 25 Social Studies– Click Map reading & Qu.

OR

Go back to vrae.org - Go to resources and click GED websites for students

Scroll down on the right to Thomas Jefferson Adult and Career Education

Click Social Studies – Scroll down to find the four areas on the Social Studies test and click any of these:

- Civics -
